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Clerk-Recorder Lifts Restrictions on Vital Records Copies

After months of hard work, Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen is pleased to announce that his department has been able to secure a steady source of banknote paper and will be lifting all restrictions on orders of birth, death and marriage certificates immediately.

For several months, the department has been limiting the number of certificates customers could order due to a state-wide shortage of banknote paper. The department was also not processing mail orders of these records. Banknote paper is the paper that contains state mandated security features and that county recorders must use to print certified copies of vital records.

The department received its first large order of banknote paper this past Thursday guaranteeing that the department would continue issuing these important records to the public. The department was running critically low but managed to avert running out of paper by implementing strategically timed restrictions.

“I was not happy about the restrictions,” said Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen. “I’m extremely pleased to lift the restrictions and to be able to once again fully serve the public.” “I would like to personally thank Tom O’Toole from Pacific Bancnote and everyone at Veritrack Inc. for their efforts and getting this banknote paper to us.”

Pacific Bancnote was able to find a new printer, Veritrack Inc., who worked tirelessly to set-up shop and work overnight to be able to deliver the initial supply of banknote paper to the department.
